Tuesday, March 21. 6:30 Wind chimes

This is a beginner class. Students will make Windchimes designed from glass. Students will learn safety in the studio, how to use glass tools and will learn how to cut glass. Come in and make your summer wind chimes. These beautiful glass chimes have sparkle beautifully in the sunshine and have a pleasant soft tinkle. Cost is 25.00 plus HST of 3.75 for a total of \$28.75.

Tuesday, March 28. 6:30 Glass Landscape Scene

This is a beginner class. Students will make a glass nature landscape scene to be displayed on an easel. Students will learn safety in the studio, how to use glass tools and will learn how to cut glass. Cost is \$30.00 plus HST(4.50) for a total of \$35.50.

Fluid Painting

This concept of fluid painting in its entirety is a spontaneous technique and a beautiful way to paint. You will get color mixtures and results that will absolutely blow your mind once you get comfortable with the medium. You will learn to add different materials in combination with your paint to create stunning reactions as well as loosen up the painting style in order to rapidly create an abstract piece of work without over-thinking in. You will receive two canvases to create in a class. The drying time to create these paintings can take up to a couple of days. Classes take place on a Thursday night so they can dry all day Friday while the studio is closed. All materials will be provided for each class.

Cost for each class is \$70.00 plus HST(\$10.50) for a total of \$80.50 You can take only one class or you can take more. Registration and a minimum of 4 students per class is required.

The art of ceramic surface decoration is a never-ending venture. Good decoration requires experimentation, trial and error, and practice, practice, practice. In this weekend workshop, students will learn the basics of ceramic surface decoration. Processes learned in this class can later be applied to future ceramic endeavors. Technical skills such as carving, sloop trailing, spring mould applique and a variety of glaze applications will be explored in this workshop. Students will work on ceramic tiles (provided) that can later be kept as samples or hung as wall art pieces. While the workshop will primarily be hands on, it is recommended that students bring a notebook for keeping notes. The workshop is best suited for individuals that have a basic understanding of the ceramic pieces and have a beginner's knowledge or working with clay.

Felted Boxes:

This is a class for those who want to learn about wet felting. You will create a felted box around a block of wood or smooth stone. You will then cut it open so you can embellish it with embroidery and beads, and then you will add a lining. This is a process, but well worth the time invested. You will have a unique one of a kind piece of art that will be incredible. Week one: Working with roving to start the felting process. Week two: Cutting open your felted piece and starting on embellishment. Week three: More embellishment. Week four: Adding the lining to your piece. **Monday Night** 7:00-8:30pm March 6,12, 20, 27. Cost for this project is \$95.00 plus HST(14.25) for a total of \$109.25

Introduction to Life Drawing

Art Studio 138 is pleased to offer a six week "Introduction to Life Drawing" Class. Britt-Lise Newstead will be instructing this class. Britt-Lise is a Storyboard Artists, Concept Artist and Illustrator currently residing in Shelburne, NS. Over her career she has drawn Romans, Barbarians and whimsical scenes for Longbow Games, as well as working as a Storyboard Revisionist on the Transformers: Rescue Bots with

DHX Media. In her off time she indulges continues her studies with smARt School and Master Illustrator Class, and now Dalhousie University. You can view Britt-Lise's work at www.BrittNewstead.com

A brief outline of the class is as follows:

Week One: Introduction to Materials, Assessing Skill, and introduction Portraits

Week Two: Introduction to Drawing from Life - Still Life, Drawing 3D Shapes, Light & Shadow, Drawing Through, Perspective: The basics of all drawing.

Week Three: Expanding Thought & Technique - Learning to look at Life through an Artist's eyes, and begin to see what is really there. Realism vs Abstractionism

Week Four: Introduction to Figure Drawing - Drawing a living model in the studio. Gesture vs Rendering, and how to make the best use of your time with the model.

Week Five: Figure Drawing - A class completely devoted to practicing life drawing.

Week Six: Final Project. Planning a life drawing from set up to execution.

Critique Session – This is not required. Britt-Lise will do a 30 minute critique of your work from the class. This will not be for the faint of heart, but it is the best way to improve your skill.

Upcoming in April will be **Oil Painting** with **Dennis Teakle!** Dennis will be teaching a 6 week class in oil painting at the studio. This will take place on Wed. Nights 6-9 pm starting on April 5th.

Week One – Introduction to Materials, student evaluation and Still life painting.

Week Two – Six – Individual projects based on your personal photographs.

Cost is 200.00 plus HST(30.00) for a total of \$230.00 Materials are not included and a materials list is available at the studio. We can provide a materials package if interested. A minimum of 4 students is required for this class to be a go. Please contact the studio if you are interested in this class.
